- 2. In addition preliminary contact has been made with:

  - b) Leicester, Leicestershire & Rutland Resilience Partnership Officer Helen Hardy
  - c) Uppingham Town Council Clerk and Proper Officer Debbie Nettles
  - d) Uppingham Surgery Practice Manager Vicki Abbott
  - e) Uppingham Schools
- 3. Noted that:
  - a) Robust procedures are in place with daily reporting by schools and proactive action being taken by surgery
  - b) Volunteer numbers can be expanded (now being actioned)
  - c) Town council is well represented in the Lead Coordinator group
  - d) Future communication may need to be electronic if situation deteriorates or national advice changes
- 4. Actions agreed
  - a) Situation and professional advice is changing daily and will therefore be monitored closely
  - b) Emergency Plan and UppWatch volunteers to be contacted and contact details updated
  - c) Communication equipment to be charged up, tested and deployed in two or more locations
  - d) Inaugural conference call details to be agreed and circulated to approved volunteers
  - e) Team communication and support capability to be communicated to Surgery leads
  - f) Selected media and social media channel support to be offered as required
  - g) Household newsletter rapid delivery team to be readied for distribution of approved communications
  - h) CTA advice on community transport and Uppingham Hopper to be followed where appropriate
  - Voluntary sector resident databases to be utilised where approved
  - j) Town council to be incorporated into distribution of meeting notes
  - k) Updated report to be submitted to Uppingham First Board on April 7<sup>th</sup>
