# **Uppingham Community Emergency Plan**

Minutes of a Virtual Meeting of Lead Coordinators held on Sunday January 10<sup>th</sup> 2021 at 4pm

#### 1. Online Roll Call

All eight of the lead coordinators detailed in the Uppingham Community Emergency Plan were visually confirmed as present online with the meeting being chaired by Janet Thompson.

## 4. Update

Further to a meeting earlier in the week the Coordinator Group was meeting again, as agreed, to update a number of actions.

### 5. Action Update

Following discussion, the following actions were agreed: -

- a) Uppingham Hopper Following data on passenger needs, numbers, medicine deliveries, food deliveries, expenditure and donations, it was agreed to invite Uppingham First to continue operating the full Hopper timetable for a further week
- b) Home Learning To assist with home learning it was agreed to support the distribution of Android Tablets donated by local company ClockedIn to families which had registered interest from Uppingham and Caldecott
- c) Mental Health and Social Isolation Action Programme Following a response and quotation from Danny Hern of Rocky Road Music it was agreed that the quotation be accepted and that the committee collaborate with social and economic partners to mount a first community support event on February 14<sup>th</sup> 2021, Valentine's Night. Uppingham First will act as the committee's agent to contract with local artists and musicians.

During the meeting, a test of the committee's emergency communication equipment was undertaken.

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
